Weed Wrangle®-Grants Pass, is a one-day, volunteer effort to help rescue our public parks from invasive species through hands-on removal of especially harmful plants. The goal is to heighten awareness while actively removing the problem. Experts on invasive plant species will be there to help educate the public and demonstrate methods for proper removal and disposal.

This year's event will take place at Griffin Park along the beautiful Rogue River (500 Griffin Road, Grants Pass, OR) on Saturday, March 4, 2017. We will focus on removing Scotch broom and other invasive plants that are taking over the native landscape.

Partners throughout the region, including the Oregon Dept of Foresty's Firewise program, our Cooperative Weed Management Association, and the Josephine County Parks will be participating in the event. For participants, we will have tools available to use and the County Park day-use fee will be waived.
