RBP Investment Strategy draft review

- Kendra Smith explains impetus for this document, the different parts and how it could be used moving forward
- Jack Shipley reminds folks of ecological impact of investing in the basin biodiversity gives investors bang for buck
- Kelly Coates states, how this will be coordinated is the crucial next step
- Kendra suggests dedicating time in coordinating who checks in with folks; divvy up ground with
 who knows who with foundations; grants are more in the implementers wheel house, folks can
 help each other connect the dots if they know what projects are in the pipeline...CIP
- Gail suggests EAC to process. Working with staff to ask members who they have relationships to update document
- Paige wonders how to find ambassadors to join our board?
- Kendra suggests tapping into social networks. Extraverts with mission and message plugged into their minds; Potential coaching? Approach with specific asks.

Training by buddy system?

- Jack Shipley has talked with Sybil. Once RBP gets their act together they are willing to convene something; foundations want to give in a bundle with other foundations
- Kendra reminds folks to build out CIP. Then we can know what do we need money for, what is in the pipeline.
- Denis brings up operationalizing the strategy. How far do we need to get in the strategic planning process before we go a knockin'?
- Kendra replies that the strategic plan needs to be pretty and tell our story, but shouldn't be hard because there is a lot of organizational planning behind RBP already.
- Jake inquires, if we are contacted/know new or unexpected foundations? → talk to Sam...need to capture this on page 4 on fundraising strategy;

Hypothetical: Meyer has an application for April – float out to membership to see who is applying?

- Kendra suggests excel dates need to be updated in fundraising strategy tables
- Eugene suggests developing table of who has money from who for what to help track...internal; timeline chart would be lovely
- Kendra: additional feedback in the next week; training to ambassadors (seek partner development folks), spend time on moving this along regularly.
- Potentially reach out to development directors KS Wild, WW, NFS each employ one Motion: To edit page 4 to reflect Board Retreat decisions regarding Sam's role as point person. To adopt and accept as a working RBP document.

RBP strategic planning process - next steps

- Desire for this comes from foundational interest & to act as a road map for staff to move forward
- 3 yr road map helpful for staff tied to foundation asks and guides organizations asking from RBP support/sponsorship/in-kind
- Paige suggests it should outline staff and board responsibilities & how we work together
- Governance Committee had discussed sending out an RFP and hiring a facilitator for the process, but Kendra had it in her contract originally and has the capacity to fulfill; much of the past RBP documentation will feed into and it would take a new facilitator time and effort to get up to speed General agreement that Kendra will keep on with her contract and develop an RBP strategic plan
- Denis raised concern about prioritization and selection of projects
 Kelly sees the FIP Lite and Strategic Plan are separate

Gail suggests the selection process is an action item in the strategic plan

Thera recognizes the concern is valid, but can't precede the CIP build out since we don't have any projects to prioritize; we can develop these simultaneously
